- 1 AN ACT Relating to providing paratransit bus services for 2 individuals with disabilities; adding a new chapter to Title 81 RCW;
- 3 and providing an effective date.

State of Washington

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that maintaining existing boundaries of paratransit bus services for individuals with disabilities is necessary to prevent the loss of such services in the
- 8 event a transit agency removes fixed routes or alters those routes.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.
- (1) "Fixed route system" means a system of transporting individuals (other than by aircraft), including the provision of designated public transportation service by a transit agency or by a private entity, on which a vehicle is operated along a prescribed route according to a fixed schedule.
- 16 (2) "Paratransit service" means comparable transportation service 17 required by the Americans with Disabilities Act (104 Stat. 327, 42

- 1 U.S.C. Sec. 12101 et seq.), as amended from time to time, and chapter
- 2 49.60 RCW, for individuals with disabilities who are unable to use
- 3 fixed route systems.
- 4 (3) "Private entity" means any entity other than a public entity.
- 5 (4) "Public entity" means (a) any state or local government, (b)
- 6 any department, agency, special purpose district, or other 7 instrumentality of one or more state or local governments, and (c) any
- 8 transit agency.
- 9 (5) "Transit agency" means a city that operates a transit system,
- 10 a public transportation benefit area, a county transportation
- 11 authority, a metropolitan municipal corporation, or a regional transit
- 12 authority as defined in chapter 81.112 RCW.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. (1) Each public entity operating a fixed
- 14 route system shall provide paratransit service to individuals with
- 15 disabilities that is comparable to the level of service provided to
- 16 individuals without disabilities who use the fixed route system.
- 17 paratransit service will be deemed to meet the requirements of this
- 18 subsection if the system provides a level of service that meets the
- 19 needs of individuals with and without disabilities to a comparable
- 20 extent.
- 21 (2) Each public entity operating a fixed route system shall not
- 22 reduce paratransit service below the level of service required by
- 23 subsection (1) of this section for any fixed route existing as of the
- 24 effective date of this act.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. If any provision of this act or its
- 26 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 27 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 28 persons or circumstances is not affected.
- 29 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** If any part of this act is found to be in
- 30 conflict with federal requirements that are a prescribed condition to
- 31 the allocation of federal funds to the state, the conflicting part of
- 32 this act is inoperative solely to the extent of the conflict and with
- 33 respect to the agencies directly affected, and this finding does not
- 34 affect the operation of the remainder of this act in its application to

- 1 the agencies concerned. Rules adopted under this act must meet federal
- 2 requirements that are a necessary condition to the receipt of federal
- 3 funds by the state.
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** This act takes effect July 1, 2006.
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** Sections 1 through 6 of this act constitute
- 6 a new chapter in Title 81 RCW.
