- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9.41 RCW 6 to read as follows:
  - (1) It shall be unlawful for any person, acting alone or with others, to threaten to use a firearm against any persons on public or private elementary or secondary school premises, school-provided transportation, or areas of facilities while being used exclusively by
- 11 public or private schools, who are engaged in the peaceful discharge of
- 12 their studies, duties, or activities; or to communicate or repeat any
- 13 information concerning such a threatened use of a firearm, knowing such
- 14 information to be false and with intent to alarm the person or persons
- 15 to whom the information is communicated or repeated.

- 17 that the threatened use of a firearm was a hoax.
