1 AN ACT Relating to assisted living facility medicaid minimum
2 occupancy percentage of fifty percent or greater; adding a new section
3 to chapter 74.39A RCW; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 74.39A RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 The department shall establish a capital add-on rate, not less than
8 the July 1, 2005, capital add-on rate established by the department,
9 for those assisted living facilities contracting with the department
10 that have a medicaid minimum occupancy percentage of sixty percent or
11 greater. The medicaid minimum occupancy percentage shall be determined
12 on an annual basis. In determining whether an assisted living facility
13 meets the medicaid minimum occupancy percentage established under this
14 section, the department shall include in the calculation of medicaid
15 days those clients who are enrolled in a managed care delivery system
16 for receipt of long-term care services, including but not limited to
17 the program for all inclusive care and the medicaid integration
18 project.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** If specific funding for the purposes of this
2 act, referencing this act by bill or chapter number, is not provided by
3 June 30, 2006, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act is null and
4 void.

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
