## SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 2934

AN ACT Relating to the retirement allowance of a member who is killed in the course of employment; amending RCW 41.26.510; amending 2001 c 165 s 6 (uncodified); and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 41.26.510 and 2004 c 5 s 1 are each amended to read as 6 follows:

7 (1) Except as provided in RCW 11.07.010, if a member or a vested 8 member who has not completed at least ten years of service dies, the amount of the accumulated contributions standing to such member's 9 10 credit in the retirement system at the time of such member's death, less any amount identified as owing to an obligee upon withdrawal of 11 12 accumulated contributions pursuant to a court order filed under RCW 41.50.670, shall be paid to the member's estate, or such person or 13 14 persons, trust, or organization as the member shall have nominated by written designation duly executed and filed with the department. 15 Ιf there be no such designated person or persons still living at the time 16 of the member's death, such member's accumulated contributions standing 17 to such member's credit in the retirement system, less any amount 18 19 identified as owing to an obligee upon withdrawal of accumulated 1 contributions pursuant to a court order filed under RCW 41.50.670,
2 shall be paid to the member's surviving spouse as if in fact such
3 spouse had been nominated by written designation, or if there be no
4 such surviving spouse, then to such member's legal representatives.

5 (2) If a member who is eligible for retirement or a member who has 6 completed at least ten years of service dies, the surviving spouse or 7 eligible child or children shall elect to receive either:

(a) A retirement allowance computed as provided for in RCW 8 41.26.430, actuarially reduced by the amount of any lump sum benefit 9 identified as owing to an obligee upon withdrawal of accumulated 10 contributions pursuant to a court order filed under RCW 41.50.670 and 11 12 actuarially adjusted to reflect a joint and one hundred percent 13 survivor option under RCW 41.26.460 and if the member was not eligible for normal retirement at the date of death a further reduction as 14 described in RCW 41.26.430; if a surviving spouse who is receiving a 15 retirement allowance dies leaving a child or children of the member 16 17 under the age of majority, then such child or children shall continue to receive an allowance in an amount equal to that which was being 18 received by the surviving spouse, share and share alike, until such 19 child or children reach the age of majority; if there is no surviving 20 21 spouse eligible to receive an allowance at the time of the member's 22 death, such member's child or children under the age of majority shall receive an allowance share and share alike calculated as herein 23 24 provided making the assumption that the ages of the spouse and member 25 were equal at the time of the member's death; or

(b)(i) The member's accumulated contributions, less any amount identified as owing to an obligee upon withdrawal of accumulated contributions pursuant to a court order filed under RCW 41.50.670; or

(ii) If the member dies on or after July 25, 1993, one hundred fifty percent of the member's accumulated contributions, less any amount identified as owing to an obligee upon withdrawal of accumulated contributions pursuant to a court order filed under RCW 41.50.670. Any accumulated contributions attributable to restorations made under RCW 41.50.165(2) shall be refunded at one hundred percent.

35 (3) If a member who is eligible for retirement or a member who has 36 completed at least ten years of service dies after October 1, 1977, and 37 is not survived by a spouse or an eligible child, then the accumulated 38 contributions standing to the member's credit, less any amount 1 identified as owing to an obligee upon withdrawal of accumulated 2 contributions pursuant to a court order filed under RCW 41.50.670, 3 shall be paid:

4 (a) To an estate, a person or persons, trust, or organization as
5 the member shall have nominated by written designation duly executed
6 and filed with the department; or

7 (b) If there is no such designated person or persons still living 8 at the time of the member's death, then to the member's legal 9 representatives.

10 (4) The retirement allowance of a member who is killed in the 11 course of employment, as determined by the director of the department 12 of labor and industries, is not subject to an actuarial reduction. The 13 member's retirement allowance is computed under RCW 41.26.420.

14 (5) The retirement allowance paid to the spouse and dependent 15 children of a member who is killed in the course of employment, as set 16 forth in RCW 41.05.011(14), shall include reimbursement for any 17 payments of premium rates to the Washington state health care authority 18 pursuant to RCW 41.05.080. Eligibility for coverage shall be as 19 determined in rules governing benefits offered by the public employees' 20 benefits board.

21 sec. 2. 2001 c 165 s 6 (uncodified) is amended to read as follows: This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 22 23 peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its 24 existing public institutions, and except for section 2 of this act takes effect immediately [May 7, 2001]. This act applies to all 25 26 surviving spouses and dependent children of (1) emergency service personnel and (2) members of the law enforcement officers' and fire 27 fighters' retirement system plan 2, killed in the line of duty ((on or 28 after January 1, 1998)). 29

30 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. The legislature reserves the right to amend 31 or repeal this act in the future and no member or beneficiary has a 32 contractual right to receive any distribution not granted prior to that 33 time.

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
