1 AN ACT Relating to record checks for developmental disabilities
2 service providers; and adding a new section to chapter 71A.12 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 71A.12 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 All persons who provide services under this chapter and who will
7 have regularly scheduled unsupervised access to persons with
8 developmental disabilities are required to submit to a record check
9 through the Washington state patrol criminal identification system
10 under RCW 43.43.830 through 43.43.834, 10.97.030, and 10.97.050, and
11 through the federal bureau of investigation. The record check shall
12 include a fingerprint check using a complete Washington state criminal
13 identification fingerprint card. The requesting entity shall provide
14 a copy of the record report to the applicant. When necessary, persons
15 may be employed on a conditional basis pending completion of the
16 investigation. If the applicant has had a record check within the
17 previous two years, the agency may waive the requirement.
