AN ACT Relating to endangered wildlife license plates; amending RCW 77.12.170; reenacting and amending RCW 46.16.313; and adding new sections to chapter 46.16 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW 6 to read as follows:

7 (1) The legislature recognizes that the Endangered Wildlife license
8 plate has been reviewed by the special license plate review board under
9 RCW 46.16.725 and was found to fully comply with all provisions of RCW
10 46.16.715 through 46.16.775.

(2) The department shall issue a special license plate displaying a symbol or artwork, approved by the special license plate review board and the legislature, referred to as "Endangered Wildlife license plates," that may be used in lieu of regular or personalized license plates for vehicles required to display one or two vehicle license plates, excluding vehicles registered under chapter 46.87 RCW, upon terms and conditions established by the department. <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW
 to read as follows:

For the purposes of RCW 46.16.313 and section 1 of this act, the term "Endangered Wildlife license plates" means license plates issued under section 1 of this act that display a symbol or artwork symbolizing endangered wildlife in Washington state.

7 Sec. 3. RCW 46.16.313 and 2004 c 221 s 3, 2004 c 48 s 3, and 2004 8 c 35 s 3 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

(1) The department may establish a fee of no more than forty 9 dollars for each type of special license plates issued under RCW 10 46.16.301(1) (a), (b), or (c), as existing before amendment by section 11 5, chapter 291, Laws of 1997, in an amount calculated to offset the 12 cost of production of the special license plates and the administration 13 of this program. This fee is in addition to all other fees required to 14 register and license the vehicle for which the plates have been 15 16 requested. All such additional special license plate fees collected by 17 the department shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to the motor vehicle fund. 18

19 (2) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a 20 21 collegiate license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of 22 23 each fee collected under this subsection for administration and 24 collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 25 26 identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in 27 RCW 28B.10.890. 28

(3) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 29 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a collegiate 30 31 license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under 32 this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by 33 The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the 34 it. state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. 35 The state 36 treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license 37 plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890.

(4) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 1 2 application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a special baseball stadium license plate shall pay an initial fee of 3 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed 4 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for 5 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining 6 7 proceeds, minus the cost of plate production, shall be distributed to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments 8 9 on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as 10 defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 11 12 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds 13 to the state general fund.

14 (5) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special 15 baseball stadium license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. 16 The 17 department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection 18 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be distributed 19 to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest 20 21 payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, 22 as defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 23 24 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds 25 to the state general fund.

(6) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on 26 27 January 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a 28 professional fire fighters and paramedics license plate shall pay an 29 initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount 30 not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this 31 32 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state 33 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 34 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor 35 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been 36 37 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the professional fire fighters 38 and paramedics license plates. Upon the determination by the

department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall
 credit the proceeds to the Washington State Council of Fire Fighters
 benevolent fund established under RCW 46.16.30902.

(7) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 4 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 5 renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a professional fire 6 7 fighters and paramedics license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to 8 exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for 9 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. 10 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a 11 12 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state 13 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 14 cost of implementing the professional fire fighters and paramedics 15 special license plate. Upon the determination by the department that 16 17 the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the Washington State Council of Fire Fighters benevolent fund 18 established under RCW 46.16.30902. 19

(8) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on 20 21 November 1, 2004, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 22 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a "Helping Kids Speak" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty 23 24 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars. dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 25 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be 26 27 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state 28 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 29 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 30 cost of implementing the "Helping Kids Speak" special license plate. 31 32 Upon the determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Helping 33 Kids Speak" account established under RCW 46.16.30904. 34

(9) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on November 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "Helping Kids Speak" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars.

The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each 1 2 fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to 3 the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed 4 5 report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department 6 7 determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the "Helping Kids Speak" special license plate. Upon the 8 9 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the 10 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Helping Kids Speak" account established under RCW 46.16.30904. 11

12 (10) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on 13 January 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 14 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a "law enforcement memorial" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty 15 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve 16 17 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall 18 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 19 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state 20 21 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 22 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the law enforcement memorial special license 23 24 plate. Upon the determination by the department that the state has 25 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the law enforcement memorial account established under RCW 46.16.30906. 26

27 (11) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 28 renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "law enforcement 29 memorial" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty 30 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two 31 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 32 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall 33 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 34 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state 35 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 36 37 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the law enforcement memorial special license 38

plate. Upon the determination by the department that the state has
 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the law
 enforcement memorial account established under RCW 46.16.30906.

4 (12)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required 5 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder 6 7 of an Endangered Wildlife license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed 8 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for 9 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining 10 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a 11 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state 12 13 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 14 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the Endangered Wildlife license plate. Upon 15 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the 16 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the state wildlife account. 17 Proceeds credited to the state wildlife account from the sale of the 18 19 Endangered Wildlife license plates must be used only for the department of fish and wildlife's endangered wildlife program activities. 20

21 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 22 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of an Endangered 23 24 Wildlife license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two 25 26 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be 27 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 28 identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer 29 shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the 30 department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost 31 of implementing the Endangered Wildlife license plate. Upon 32 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the 33 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the state wildlife account. 34 Proceeds credited to the state wildlife account from the sale of the 35 36 Endangered Wildlife license plates must be used only for the department

37 of fish and wildlife's endangered wildlife program activities.

Sec. 4. RCW 77.12.170 and 2004 c 248 s 4 are each amended to read 1 2 as follows: (1) There is established in the state treasury the state wildlife 3 ((fund)) account which consists of moneys received from: 4 5 (a) Rentals or concessions of the department; (b) The sale of real or personal property held for department б 7 purposes; (c) The sale of licenses, permits, tags, and stamps required by 8 chapter 77.32 RCW and RCW 77.65.490, except annual resident adult 9 saltwater and all annual razor clam and shellfish licenses, which shall 10 be deposited into the state general fund; 11 12 (d) Fees for informational materials published by the department; 13 (e) Fees for personalized vehicle and Endangered Wildlife license 14 plates as provided in chapter 46.16 RCW; (f) Articles or wildlife sold by the director under this title; 15 (g) Compensation for damage to department property or wildlife 16 17 losses or contributions, gifts, or grants received under RCW 77.12.320; (h) Excise tax on anadromous game fish collected under chapter 18 82.27 RCW; 19 20 (i) The sale of personal property seized by the department for 21 fish, shellfish, or wildlife violations; 22 (j) The department's share of revenues from auctions and raffles 23 authorized by the commission; and 24 (k) The sale of watchable wildlife decals under RCW 77.32.560. 25 (2) State and county officers receiving any moneys listed in subsection (1) of this section shall deposit them in the state treasury 26 27 to be credited to the state wildlife ((fund)) account.

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
