1 AN ACT Relating to student athletes' bill of rights; and adding a 2 new section to chapter 28B.10 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 RCW
to read as follows:

6 (1) An institution of higher education may not agree to, or be 7 subject to, the rules or policies of any organization, association, or 8 any other type of entity, nor make a contract with any party, that 9 dictates the terms, value, and conditions of student athlete 10 scholarships relating to any of the following:

(a) The terms or duration of a scholarship or stipend the value of which is below the actual cost of attendance at that institution;

13 (b) The amount earned from bona fide employment not associated with 14 their sport;

15 (c) Health insurance;

16 (d) The ability to obtain licensed representation in making career 17 choices;

18 (e) The ability to transfer to another institution of higher

1 education if a head coach leaves the school of attendance or 2 anticipated attendance.

3 (2) No institution of higher education that maintains an 4 intercollegiate athletics program may impose, or submit to the 5 imposition of, a penalty or other sanction on a student athlete for a 6 violation of a rule or code of conduct of an intercollegiate athletics 7 association that was not committed by that student athlete.

8 (3) As used in this section, "penalty or other sanction" includes, 9 but is not necessarily limited to, the cancellation or forfeiting of an 10 athletic event.

11 (4) This section may be known and cited as the "student athletes' 12 bill of rights."
