- 1 AN ACT Relating to the agency council on coordinated
- 2 transportation; and amending RCW 47.06B.020 and 47.06B.901.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.06B.020 and 1998 c 173 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) The agency council on coordinated transportation is created.
 7 The council is composed of ((nine)) ten voting members and eight
- 8 nonvoting, legislative members.
- 9 (2) The ((nine)) ten voting members are the superintendent of public instruction or a designee, the secretary of transportation or a
- 11 designee, the secretary of the department of social and health services
- 12 or a designee, a designee of the Washington utilities and
- 13 <u>transportation commission</u>, and six members appointed by the governor as
- 14 follows:
- 15 (a) One representative from the office of the governor;
- 16 (b) Two persons who are consumers of special needs transportation services;
- 18 (c) One representative from the Washington association of pupil transportation;

- (i) A representative from the community transportation association of the Northwest; or
- 6 (ii) A representative from the community action council 7 association.
 - (3) The eight nonvoting members are legislators as follows:
- 9 (a) Four members from the house of representatives, two from each of the two largest caucuses, appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives, two who are members of the house transportation policy and budget committee and two who are members of the house appropriations committee; and
 - (b) Four members from the senate, two from each of the two largest caucuses, appointed by the president of the senate, two members of the transportation committee and two members of the ways and means committee.
 - (4) Gubernatorial appointees of the council will serve two-year terms. Members may not receive compensation for their service on the council, but will be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred in performing their duties as members as set forth in RCW 43.03.220.
- 23 (5) The secretary of transportation or a designee shall serve as 24 the chair.
- 25 (6) The department of transportation shall provide necessary staff 26 support for the council.
 - (7) The council may receive gifts, grants, or endowments from public or private sources that are made from time to time, in trust or otherwise, for the use and benefit of the purposes of the council and spend gifts, grants, or endowments or income from the public or private sources according to their terms, unless the receipt of the gifts, grants, or endowments violates RCW 42.17.710.
