- 1 AN ACT Relating to reporting drug overdoses; and adding a new 2 section to chapter 69.50 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 69.50 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- A person shall not be charged, subject to civil forfeiture, or otherwise prosecuted for a violation of this chapter if:
  - (1) The person was a witness to a drug overdose;

- 9 (2) The overdose resulted in an imminent threat to the health or life of the overdose victim;
- 11 (3) The person reported the drug overdose to law enforcement or 12 summoned medical assistance at the time it was witnessed; and
- 13 (4) All evidence of the specific violation was gained as a result 14 of the person's report.
