- A combination fishing license shall, upon written application, be issued at no charge to a resident seventy years old or older, and at the reduced rate of five dollars to the following individuals:
- 9 (1) Residents who are honorably discharged veterans of the United 10 States armed forces with a thirty percent or more service-connected 11 disability;
  - (2) A person who is blind;
