AN ACT Relating to the "Share the Road" special license plate to commemorate Cooper Jones; amending RCW 46.16.333; reenacting and amending RCW 46.16.313 and 43.59.150; adding new sections to chapter 46.16 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 46.04 RCW.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW 7 to read as follows:

8 (1) The legislature recognizes that the "Share the Road" license 9 plate has been reviewed by the special license plate review board under 10 RCW 46.16.725, and found to fully comply with RCW 46.16.715 through 11 46.16.775.

12 (2) The department shall issue a special license plate displaying 13 a symbol or artwork, approved by the special license plate review board 14 and the legislature, recognizing an organization that promotes bicycle 15 safety and awareness education. The special license plate may be used 16 in lieu of regular or personalized license plates for vehicles required 17 to display one or two vehicle license plates, excluding vehicles 18 registered under chapter 46.87 RCW, upon terms and conditions established by the department. The special plates will commemorate the
life of Cooper Jones.

3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 46.04 RCW 4 to read as follows:

5 "Share the Road license plates" means license plates that 6 commemorate the life of Cooper Jones and display a symbol of an 7 organization that promote bicycle safety and awareness education in 8 communities throughout Washington.

9 Sec. 3. RCW 46.16.313 and 2004 c 221 s 3, 2004 c 48 s 3, and 2004 10 c 35 s 3 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

(1) The department may establish a fee of no more than forty 11 dollars for each type of special license plates issued under RCW 12 46.16.301(1) (a), (b), or (c), as existing before amendment by section 13 5, chapter 291, Laws of 1997, in an amount calculated to offset the 14 15 cost of production of the special license plates and the administration of this program. This fee is in addition to all other fees required to 16 register and license the vehicle for which the plates have been 17 requested. All such additional special license plate fees collected by 18 19 the department shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to 20 the motor vehicle fund.

(2) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 21 22 application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a 23 collegiate license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of 24 25 each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be 26 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 27 identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the 28 29 funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890. 30

31 (3) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 32 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a collegiate 33 license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall 34 deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under 35 this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by 36 it. The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the

state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state
treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license
plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890.

(4) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 4 application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a 5 special baseball stadium license plate shall pay an initial fee of 6 7 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for 8 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. 9 The remaining 10 proceeds, minus the cost of plate production, shall be distributed to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments 11 12 on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as 13 defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary 14 preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds 15 16 to the state general fund.

17 (5) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special 18 baseball stadium license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. 19 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee 20 21 collected under this subsection for administration and collection 22 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be distributed to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest 23 24 payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, 25 defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary as preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 26 27 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds to the state general fund. 28

(6) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on 29 January 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 30 31 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a 32 professional fire fighters and paramedics license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount 33 not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this 34 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. 35 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state 36 37 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 38 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor

vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the professional fire fighters and paramedics license plates. Upon the determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the Washington State Council of Fire Fighters benevolent fund established under RCW 46.16.30902.

(7) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 7 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 8 renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a professional fire 9 10 fighters and paramedics license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to 11 exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for 12 13 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a 14 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state 15 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 16 17 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the professional fire fighters and paramedics 18 special license plate. Upon the determination by the department that 19 the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds 20 21 to the Washington State Council of Fire Fighters benevolent fund established under RCW 46.16.30902. 22

(8) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on 23 24 November 1, 2004, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 25 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a 26 "Helping Kids Speak" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty 27 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 28 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be 29 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 30 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state 31 32 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 33 cost of implementing the "Helping Kids Speak" special license plate. 34 35 Upon the determination by the department that the state has been 36 reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Helping 37 Kids Speak" account established under RCW 46.16.30904.

(9) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on November 1 2 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "Helping Kids Speak" 3 license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. 4 5 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection 6 7 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed 8 Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit 9 report. 10 the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of 11 12 implementing the "Helping Kids Speak" special license plate. Upon the 13 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the 14 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Helping Kids Speak" account established under RCW 46.16.30904. 15

16 (10) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on 17 January 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a "law 18 enforcement memorial" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty 19 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve 20 21 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 22 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 23 24 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state 25 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 26 27 cost of implementing the law enforcement memorial special license plate. Upon the determination by the department that the state has 28 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the law 29 enforcement memorial account established under RCW 46.16.30906. 30

(11) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 31 32 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "law enforcement 33 34 memorial" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two 35 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 36 37 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall 38 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper

1 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state 2 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 3 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 4 cost of implementing the law enforcement memorial special license 5 plate. Upon the determination by the department that the state has 6 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the law 7 enforcement memorial account established under RCW 46.16.30906.

(12)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due 8 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required 9 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder 10 of a "Share the Road" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty 11 12 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve 13 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be 14 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 15 identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer 16 shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the 17 department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost 18 of implementing the "Share the Road" license plate. Upon determination 19 by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer 20 21 shall credit the proceeds to the "Share the Road" account established 22 under section 4 of this act.

(b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after 23 24 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "Share the 25 26 Road" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty 27 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 28 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be 29 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 30 identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer 31 shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the 32 department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost 33 of implementing the "Share the Road" license plate. Upon determination 34 by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer 35 36 shall credit the proceeds to the "Share the Road" account established under section 4 of this act. 37

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW
to read as follows:

(1) The "Share the Road" account is created in the custody of the 3 state treasurer. Upon the department's determination that the state 4 had been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the "Share the Road" 5 special license plate, all receipts, except as provided in RCW 6 7 46.16.313(12) (a) and (b), from "Share the Road" license plates must be deposited into the account. Only the director of the department of 8 licensing or the director's designee may authorize expenditures from 9 10 the account. The account is subject to allotment procedures under an appropriation is not required for 11 chapter 43.88 RCW, but 12 expenditures.

(2) Funds in the account must be disbursed subject to the followingconditions and limitations:

(a) Under the requirements set out in RCW 46.16.765, the department must contract with a qualified nonprofit organization to promote bicycle safety and awareness education in communities throughout Washington.

(b) For the purpose of this section, a "qualified nonprofit organization" means a not-for-profit corporation incorporated and of tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the federal internal revenue code. The organization must promote bicycle safety and awareness education in communities throughout Washington.

(c) The qualified nonprofit organization must meet all requirementsset out in RCW 46.16.765.

26 **Sec. 5.** RCW 46.16.333 and 2002 c 264 s 3 are each amended to read 27 as follows:

In cooperation with the Washington state patrol and the department 28 of licensing, the traffic safety commission shall create and design, 29 30 and the department shall issue, Cooper Jones license plate emblems 31 displaying a symbol of bicycle safety that may be used on motor vehicles required to display two motor vehicle license plates, 32 excluding vehicles registered under chapter 46.87 RCW, upon terms and 33 34 conditions established by the department. These license plate emblems 35 will fund the Cooper Jones act and provide funding for bicyclist and 36 pedestrian safety education, enforcement, and encouragement.

Any person may purchase Cooper Jones license plate emblems. 1 The 2 emblems are to be displayed on the vehicle license plates in the manner described by the department, existing vehicular licensing procedures, 3 and current laws. The fee for Cooper Jones emblems shall be twenty-4 five dollars. All moneys collected shall first go to the department to 5 be deposited into the motor vehicle fund until all expenses of 6 7 designing and producing the emblems are recovered. Thereafter, the department shall deduct an amount not to exceed five dollars of each 8 fee collected for Cooper Jones emblems for administration and 9 collection expenses. The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the 10 custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed 11 12 report. The state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the ((bicycle 13 and pedestrian safety account as established in RCW 43.59.150)) "Share 14 the Road" account established under section 4 of this act.

15 Sec. 6. RCW 43.59.150 and 1999 c 372 s 9 and 1999 c 351 s 1 are 16 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

17 (((1))) The Washington state traffic safety commission shall 18 establish a program for improving bicycle and pedestrian safety, and 19 shall cooperate with the stakeholders and independent representatives 20 to form an advisory committee to develop programs and create public 21 private partnerships which promote bicycle and pedestrian safety.

22 (((2) The bicycle and pedestrian safety account is created in the 23 state treasury to support bicycle and pedestrian education or safety 24 programs.))

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
