SENATE BILL 5508

- 1 AN ACT Relating to sales and use tax exemptions for light and power
- 2 businesses; adding a new section to chapter 82.08 RCW; adding a new
- 3 section to chapter 82.12 RCW; and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.08 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 shall not apply to sales of 8 machinery and equipment used directly in generating electricity by 9 light and power businesses in new generation facilities, but only if 10 the purchaser provides the seller with an exemption certificate in a 11 form and manner prescribed by the department. The seller shall retain
- 12 a copy of the certificate for the seller's files.
- 13 (2) For purposes of this section and section 2 of this act:
- 14 (a) "Light and power business" has the same meaning as defined RCW 82.16.010.
- 16 (b) "Machinery and equipment" means industrial fixtures, devices,
- 17 and support facilities that are integral and necessary to the
- 18 generation of electricity.

- (c) "Machinery and equipment" does not include: (i) Hand-powered 1 2 tools; (ii) property with a useful life of less than one year; (iii) repair parts required to restore machinery and equipment to normal 3 working order; (iv) replacement parts that do 4 not increase productivity, improve efficiency, or extend the useful life of 5 machinery and equipment; (v) buildings; or (vi) building fixtures that 6 7 are not integral and necessary to the generation of electricity that are permanently affixed to and become a physical part of a building. 8
- 9 (d) Machinery and equipment is "used directly" in generating 10 electricity if it is part of the process that converts any type of 11 nonelectrical energy into electricity.
- 12 (e) "New generation facilities" do not include facilities in 13 existence prior to the effective date of this act and are limited to 14 gas-fired generation.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 82.12 RCW to read as follows:
- 17 (1) The provisions of this chapter do not apply in respect to the 18 use by a light and power business of machinery and equipment used 19 directly in generating electricity in new generation facilities.
- 20 (2) The definitions in section 1 of this act apply to this section.
- 21 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act takes effect July 1, 2006.
