- 1 AN ACT Relating to prohibiting discrimination in life insurance
- 2 based on lawful travel destinations; and adding a new section to
- 3 chapter 48.18 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 48.18 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) No life insurer may deny or refuse to accept an application for 8 insurance, or refuse to insure, refuse to renew, cancel, restrict, or 9 otherwise terminate a policy of insurance, or charge a different rate 10 for the same coverage, based upon the applicant or insured person's 11 past or future lawful travel destinations.
- 12 (2) This section does not prohibit any action described in 13 subsection (1) of this section when the insurer bases the action on 14 sound actuarial principles.
