- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 13.34.350 and 2001 c 52 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

In order to facilitate communication of information needed to serve the best interest of any child who is the subject of a dependency case filed under this chapter, the department of social and health services shall((, consistent with state and federal law governing the release of confidential information, establish guidelines, and shall use those guidelines for the facilitation of)) convene a work group to recommend standards to be used in facilitating communication ((of relevant information among)) with department divisions, service providers, the courts, the family, caregivers, caseworkers, and others. The work group shall make recommendations regarding definitions of categories of information to be used, who should have access to categories of information, how long it is to be retained, how and when appropriate information is to be purged, compliance enforcement, and consequences for noncompliance. Recommendations shall address all forms of
