1 AN ACT Relating to the immigration status of crime victims, 2 witnesses, and others seeking assistance from law enforcement 3 personnel; and adding a new section to chapter 10.97 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 10.97 RCW 6 to read as follows:

7 General or limited authority Washington peace officers or specially 8 commissioned Washington peace officers, and general or limited authority Washington law enforcement agencies, as defined in RCW 9 10 10.93.020, shall not inquire about the immigration status of crime victims, witnesses, or others who call or approach these officers or 11 agencies seeking assistance. Officers or agencies who provide public 12 13 safety services shall not request specific documents for the sole 14 purpose of determining an individual's immigration status. However, if 15 voluntarily offered by an individual in response to a general request 16 for identification, it is permissible to rely on immigration documents 17 for the purpose of establishing the individual's identity.
