AN ACT Relating to a sales and use tax exemption for livestock and poultry feed; adding a new section to chapter 82.08 RCW; adding a new

3 section to chapter 82.12 RCW; and providing an effective date.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.08 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 does not apply to sales of feed 8 to persons for use as food for livestock and poultry.
 - (2) For the purposes of this section:

- 10 (a) "Feed" means a substance used as food to sustain or improve 11 livestock, whether in sacks or in bulk, and includes whole and 12 processed grains or mixtures of whole or processed grains, meals made 13 from hay or forages, mill feeds and feeding concentrates, salt, bone 14 meal, grit, oyster shell, hay or forages either in bales, loose, 15 compacted, processed, or unprocessed, and other similar feed;
- 16 (b) "Livestock" means cattle, camelids, sheep, horses, mules, 17 donkeys, goats, pigs, rabbits raised for meat or fur, and other such 18 mammals. "Livestock" does not include dogs, cats, guinea pigs,

- 1 gerbils, hamsters, reptiles, rabbits kept as pets, amphibians, fish, or
- 2 other like animals; and
- 3 (c) "Poultry" means chickens, turkeys, ducks, geese, pheasants,
- 4 quail, and ratites. "Poultry" does not include parrots and other like
- 5 birds.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 82.12 RCW 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (1) The provisions of this chapter do not apply in respect to the 9 use of feed as food for livestock and poultry.
- 10 (2) For the purposes of this section:
- 11 (a) "Feed" means a substance used as food to sustain or improve 12 livestock, whether in sacks or in bulk, and includes whole and 13 processed grains or mixtures of whole or processed grains, meals made 14 from hay or forages, mill feeds and feeding concentrates, salt, bone 15 meal, grit, oyster shell, hay or forages either in bales, loose, 16 compacted, processed, or unprocessed, and other similar feed;
- 17 (b) "Livestock" means cattle, camelids, sheep, horses, mules,
 18 donkeys, goats, pigs, rabbits raised for meat or fur, and other such
 19 mammals. "Livestock" does not include dogs, cats, guinea pigs,
 20 gerbils, hamsters, reptiles, rabbits kept as pets, amphibians, fish, or
 21 other like animals; and
- (c) "Poultry" means chickens, turkeys, ducks, geese, pheasants, quail, and ratites. "Poultry" does not include parrots and other like birds.
- 25 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act takes effect August 1, 2005.
