AN ACT Relating to the "Washington's National Park Fund" special license plate; reenacting and amending RCW 46.16.313; adding new sections to chapter 46.16 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 4 6.04 RCW.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW 7 to read as follows:

8 (1) The legislature recognizes that the "Washington's National Park 9 Fund" license plate has been reviewed by the special license plate 10 review board under RCW 46.16.725, and found to fully comply with RCW 11 46.16.715 through 46.16.775.

12 (2) The department shall issue a special license plate displaying 13 a symbol or artwork, approved by the special license plate review board 14 and the legislature, recognizing Washington's National Park Fund, that 15 may be used in lieu of regular or personalized license plates for 16 vehicles required to display one or two vehicle license plates, 17 excluding vehicles registered under chapter 46.87 RCW, upon terms and 18 conditions established by the department. <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 46.04 RCW
 to read as follows:

3 "Washington's National Park Fund license plates" means license 4 plates issued under section 1 of this act that display a symbol or 5 artwork recognizing the efforts of Washington's National Park Fund in 6 preserving Washington's national parks for future generations in 7 Washington state.

8 sec. 3. RCW 46.16.313 and 2004 c 221 s 3, 2004 c 48 s 3, and 2004
9 c 35 s 3 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

(1) The department may establish a fee of no more than forty 10 11 dollars for each type of special license plates issued under RCW 12 46.16.301(1) (a), (b), or (c), as existing before amendment by section 5, chapter 291, Laws of 1997, in an amount calculated to offset the 13 cost of production of the special license plates and the administration 14 of this program. This fee is in addition to all other fees required to 15 16 register and license the vehicle for which the plates have been 17 requested. All such additional special license plate fees collected by the department shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to 18 the motor vehicle fund. 19

20 (2) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 21 application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a collegiate license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. 22 23 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and 24 collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be 25 26 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 27 identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in 28 RCW 28B.10.890. 29

30 (3) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 31 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a collegiate 32 license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall 33 deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under 34 this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by 35 it. The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the 36 state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state

1 treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license
2 plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890.

(4) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 3 application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a 4 special baseball stadium license plate shall pay an initial fee of 5 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed б 7 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining 8 proceeds, minus the cost of plate production, shall be distributed to 9 10 a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as 11 12 defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary 13 preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 14 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds to the state general fund. 15

(5) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 16 17 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special baseball stadium license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. 18 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee 19 collected under this subsection for administration and collection 20 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be distributed 21 22 to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, 23 24 defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably as necessary 25 preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds 26 27 to the state general fund.

(6) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on 28 January 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 29 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a 30 professional fire fighters and paramedics license plate shall pay an 31 32 initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this 33 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. 34 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state 35 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 36 37 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor 38 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been

reimbursed for the cost of implementing the professional fire fighters and paramedics license plates. Upon the determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the Washington State Council of Fire Fighters benevolent fund established under RCW 46.16.30902.

(7) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 6 7 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a professional fire 8 fighters and paramedics license plate shall, upon application, pay a 9 10 fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for 11 12 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining 13 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a 14 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 15 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 16 cost of implementing the professional fire fighters and paramedics 17 special license plate. Upon the determination by the department that 18 the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds 19 to the Washington State Council of Fire Fighters benevolent fund 20 21 established under RCW 46.16.30902.

22 (8) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on November 1, 2004, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 23 24 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a 25 "Helping Kids Speak" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve 26 27 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be 28 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 29 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state 30 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 31 32 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the "Helping Kids Speak" special license plate. 33 Upon the determination by the department that the state has been 34 35 reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Helping 36 Kids Speak" account established under RCW 46.16.30904.

37 (9) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on November38 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon

renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "Helping Kids Speak" 1 2 license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each 3 fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection 4 5 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed б 7 report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department 8 determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of 9 10 implementing the "Helping Kids Speak" special license plate. Upon the determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the 11 12 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Helping Kids Speak" account 13 established under RCW 46.16.30904.

14 (10) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on January 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 15 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a "law 16 17 enforcement memorial" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve 18 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 19 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall 20 21 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 22 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 23 24 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 25 cost of implementing the law enforcement memorial special license Upon the determination by the department that the state has 26 plate. 27 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the law enforcement memorial account established under RCW 46.16.30906. 28

(11) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 29 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 30 renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "law enforcement 31 32 memorial" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two 33 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 34 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall 35 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 36 37 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state 38 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until

the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the law enforcement memorial special license plate. Upon the determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the law enforcement memorial account established under RCW 46.16.30906.

б (12) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to 7 be paid upon application and registration of a motor vehicle, the 8 holder of a "Washington's National Park Fund" license plate shall pay 9 an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount 10 not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this 11 12 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. 13 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 14 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor 15 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been 16 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the "Washington's National Park 17 Fund" license plate. Upon determination by the department that the 18 state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to 19 20 the "Washington's National Park Fund" account established under section 21 4 of this act.

(13) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or 22 after January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be 23 24 paid upon renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a "Washington's National Park Fund" license plate shall, upon 25 26 application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this 27 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. 28 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state 29 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 30 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor 31 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been 32 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the "Washington's National Park 33 Fund" license plate. Upon determination by the department that the 34 state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to 35 36 the "Washington's National Park Fund" account established under section 37 4 of this act.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW
 to read as follows:

(1) The "Washington's National Park Fund" account is created in the 3 custody of the state treasurer. Upon the department's determination 4 that the state had been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the 5 "Washington's National Park Fund" special license plate, all receipts, 6 7 except as provided in RCW 46.16.313 (12) and (13), from "Washington's National Park Fund" license plates must be deposited into the account. 8 Only the director of the department of licensing or the director's 9 designee may authorize expenditures from the account. The account is 10 subject to allotment procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW, but an 11 12 appropriation is not required for expenditures.

(2) Funds in the account must be disbursed subject to the followingconditions and limitations:

(a) Under the requirements set out in RCW 46.16.765, the department
 must contract with a qualified nonprofit organization to build
 awareness of Washington's national parks and to support priority park
 programs and projects in Washington's national parks.

(b) For the purpose of this section, a "qualified nonprofit organization" means a not-for-profit corporation incorporated and of tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the federal internal revenue code. The organization must have been established for the express purposes of educational and charitable activities as set forth in 26 U.S.C. Sec. 501(c)(3).

(c) The qualified nonprofit organization must meet all requirementsset out in RCW 46.16.765.

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
