- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28A.305.100 and 1982 c 160 s 1 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
  - The state board of education <u>annually</u> shall ((<u>annually</u>)) elect a president and vice president <u>and other officers</u> as the board may <u>determine</u>. The superintendent of public instruction shall be an ex officio member and the chief executive officer of the board. ((<del>As such ex officio member</del>)) The superintendent shall have the right to vote ((<del>only when there is a question before the board upon which no majority opinion has been reached among the board members present and voting thereon and the superintendent's vote is essential for action thereon)) on all matters before the board.
