AN ACT Relating to the "we love our pets" special license plates; reenacting and amending RCW 46.16.313; adding new sections to chapter 46.16 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 46.04 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW 6 to read as follows:

7 (1) The legislature recognizes that the "we love our pets" license 8 plate has been reviewed by the special license plate review board under 9 RCW 46.16.725, and found to fully comply with all provisions of RCW 10 46.16.715 through 46.16.775.

(2) The department shall issue a special license plate displaying 11 a symbol or artwork, approved by the special license plate review 12 board, recognizing an organization that assists local member agencies 13 of the federation of animal welfare and control agencies to promote and 14 15 perform spay/neuter surgery on Washington state pets, in order to reduce pet overpopulation. The special license plate may be used in 16 lieu of regular or personalized license plates for vehicles required to 17 display one or two vehicle license plates, excluding vehicles 18

registered under chapter 46.87 RCW, upon terms and conditions
 established by the department.

3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 46.04 RCW
4 to read as follows:

5 "We love our pets license plates" means license plates issued under 6 section 1 of this act that display a symbol or artwork recognizing the 7 efforts of the Washington state federation of animal care and control 8 agencies in Washington state that assists local member agencies of the 9 federation to promote and perform spay/neuter surgery of Washington 10 state pets, in order to reduce pet overpopulation.

11 sec. 3. RCW 46.16.313 and 2004 c 221 s 3, 2004 c 48 s 3, and 2004
12 c 35 s 3 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

(1) The department may establish a fee of no more than forty 13 14 dollars for each type of special license plates issued under RCW 15 46.16.301(1) (a), (b), or (c), as existing before amendment by section 5, chapter 291, Laws of 1997, in an amount calculated to offset the 16 cost of production of the special license plates and the administration 17 of this program. This fee is in addition to all other fees required to 18 19 register and license the vehicle for which the plates have been 20 requested. All such additional special license plate fees collected by 21 the department shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to 22 the motor vehicle fund.

(2) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 23 application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a 24 25 collegiate license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of 26 each fee collected under this subsection for administration and 27 collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be 28 29 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 30 identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in 31 RCW 28B.10.890. 32

33 (3) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 34 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a collegiate 35 license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall 36 deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under

this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890.

(4) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 6 7 application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a special baseball stadium license plate shall pay an initial fee of 8 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed 9 10 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. 11 The remaining 12 proceeds, minus the cost of plate production, shall be distributed to 13 a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments 14 on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as 82.14.0485, including reasonably 15 defined in RCW necessary preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 16 17 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds to the state general fund. 18

(5) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 19 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special 20 21 baseball stadium license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The 22 department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection 23 24 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be distributed 25 to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, 26 27 as defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 28 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds 29 30 to the state general fund.

(6) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on 31 32 January 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a 33 professional fire fighters and paramedics license plate shall pay an 34 initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount 35 not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this 36 37 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. 38 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state

treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 1 2 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been 3 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the professional fire fighters 4 5 and paramedics license plates. Upon the determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall 6 7 credit the proceeds to the Washington State Council of Fire Fighters benevolent fund established under RCW 46.16.30902. 8

(7) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 9 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 10 renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a professional fire 11 12 fighters and paramedics license plate shall, upon application, pay a 13 fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for 14 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining 15 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a 16 17 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 18 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 19 cost of implementing the professional fire fighters and paramedics 20 21 special license plate. Upon the determination by the department that 22 the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the Washington State Council of Fire Fighters benevolent fund 23 24 established under RCW 46.16.30902.

(8) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on 25 26 November 1, 2004, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 27 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a "Helping Kids Speak" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty 28 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve 29 dollars. dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 30 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be 31 32 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state 33 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 34 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 35 36 cost of implementing the "Helping Kids Speak" special license plate. 37 Upon the determination by the department that the state has been

reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Helping
 Kids Speak" account established under RCW 46.16.30904.

(9) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on November 3 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 4 renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "Helping Kids Speak" 5 license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. 6 7 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection 8 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to 9 10 the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit 11 report. the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department 12 13 determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of 14 implementing the "Helping Kids Speak" special license plate. Upon the determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the 15 16 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Helping Kids Speak" account 17 established under RCW 46.16.30904.

(10) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on 18 January 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 19 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a "law 20 21 enforcement memorial" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty 22 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 23 24 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall 25 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state 26 27 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 28 cost of implementing the law enforcement memorial special license 29 plate. Upon the determination by the department that the state has 30 31 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the law 32 enforcement memorial account established under RCW 46.16.30906.

(11) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "law enforcement memorial" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration

and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall 1 2 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state 3 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 4 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 5 cost of implementing the law enforcement memorial special license 6 plate. Upon the determination by the department that the state has 7 8 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the law enforcement memorial account established under RCW 46.16.30906. 9

(12)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due 10 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required 11 12 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder 13 of a "we love our pets" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty 14 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administrative 15 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall 16 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 17 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state 18 19 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 20 21 cost of implementing the "we love our pets" license plate. Upon determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the 22 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the we love our pets account 23 24 established under section 4 of this act.

(b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after 25 26 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "we love our 27 pets" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty 28 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two 29 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 30 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall 31 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 32 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state 33 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 34 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 35 36 cost of implementing the "we love our pets" license plate. Upon determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the 37

2 <u>established under section 4 of this act.</u>

3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW
4 to read as follows:

5 (1) The we love our pets account is created in the custody of the 6 state treasurer. Upon the department's determination that the state 7 has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the we love our pets special license plate, all receipts, except as provided in RCW 8 9 46.16.313(12) (a) and (b), from we love our pets license plates must be deposited into the account. Only the director of the department of 10 11 licensing or the director's designee may authorize expenditures from 12 the account. The account is subject to allotment procedures under 13 chapter 43.88 RCW, but an appropriation is not required for 14 expenditures.

(2) Funds in the account must be disbursed subject to the followingconditions and limitations:

(a) Pursuant to the requirements set out in RCW 46.16.765, the department must contract with a qualified nonprofit organization to support and to enable the Washington federation of animal welfare and control agencies to promote and perform spay/neuter surgery of Washington state pets, in order to reduce pet overpopulation.

(b) For the purposes of this section, a "qualified nonprofit 22 23 organization" means a not-for-profit corporation incorporated and 24 operating exclusively in Washington that has received a determination of tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the federal internal 25 26 revenue code. The organization must have been established for the 27 express purpose of assisting local member agencies of the federation of animal welfare and control agencies to promote and perform spay/neuter 28 surgery on Washington state pets, in order to reduce 29 pet 30 overpopulation.

31 (c) The qualified nonprofit organization must meet all requirements32 set out in RCW 46.16.765.

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
