1 AN ACT Relating to training regarding the use of force and physical  
2 restraints for school building administrators and other school security  
3 personnel; adding a new section to chapter 28A.300 RCW; and adding a  
4 new section to chapter 43.43 RCW.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.300  
7 RCW to read as follows:

8 (1) By December 30, 2005, the Washington state school safety center  
9 advisory committee, in consultation with the criminal justice training  
10 commission, shall develop a model policy and training standards for  
11 school building administrators and other school security personnel  
12 relative to the use of force and physical restraint in the common  
13 schools. The Washington state school safety center advisory committee  
14 shall report to the appropriate committees of the legislature regarding  
15 the model policy and training standards for school building  
16 administrators and other school security personnel relative to the use  
17 of force and physical restraint.

18 (2) By March 30, 2006, the model policy and training standards

1 developed under this section shall be made available to serve as  
2 guidance to school districts and educational service districts and  
3 shall be posted on the superintendent of public instruction's web site.

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.43 RCW  
5 to read as follows:

6 By June 1, 2006, the criminal justice training commission, in  
7 cooperation with the Washington state school safety center advisory  
8 committee, shall develop training materials in support of the model  
9 policy on the use of force and physical restraint.

10 Training on use of force and physical restraint shall be included  
11 in the current training provided by the criminal justice training  
12 commission as approved by, and in cooperation with, the Washington  
13 state school safety center advisory committee for school administrators  
14 and school safety personnel.
