- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 90.56.110 and 1994 c 264 s 95 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- The department of fish and wildlife may adopt rules including, but not limited to, the following:
  - (1) Procedures and methods of handling and caring for waterfowl or other wildlife affected by spills of oil and other hazardous materials;
- 10 (2) The certification of persons trained in the removal of 11 pollutants from waterfowl or other wildlife;
- 12 (3) Development of procedures with respect to removal of oil and 13 other hazardous substances from waterfowl or other wildlife;
- 14 (4) The establishment of training exercises, courses, and other training procedures as necessary(( $\dot{\tau}$
- 16 (5) Such other rules as may be reasonably necessary to carry out 17 the intent of RCW 90.56.100)).
