31 (2) With the exception of subsection (3) of this section, no person
32 shall be required to pay more than the ~~((established))~~ annual
33 registration fee ~~((adopted under this section))~~ for any weighing or
34 measuring instrument or device in any one year.

35 (3) The department or a city sealer may establish reasonable
36 inspection and testing fees for each type or class of weighing or
37 measuring instrument or device specially requested to be inspected or
38 tested by the device owner. These inspection and testing fees shall be

1 limited to those amounts necessary for the department or city sealer to
2 cover the direct costs associated with such inspection and testing.
3 The fees (~~(established under this subsection)~~) shall not be set so as
4 to compete with service agents normally engaged in such services.

5 **Sec. 2.** RCW 15.80.450 and 1969 ex.s. c 100 s 16 are each amended
6 to read as follows:

7 Any person may apply to the director for a weighmaster's license.
8 Such application shall be on a form prescribed by the director and
9 shall include:

10 (1) The full name of the person applying for such license and if
11 the applicant is a partnership, association or corporation, the full
12 name of each member of the partnership or the names of the officers of
13 the association or corporation;

14 (2) The principal business address of the applicant in this state
15 and elsewhere;

16 (3) The names of the persons authorized to receive and accept
17 service of summons and legal notice of all kinds for the applicant;

18 (4) The location of any scale or scales subject to the applicant's
19 control and from which certified weights will be issued; and

20 (5) Such other information as the director feels necessary to carry
21 out the purposes of this chapter.

22 Such annual application shall be accompanied by a license fee of
23 (~~twenty~~) fifty dollars for each scale from which certified weights
24 will be issued and a bond as provided for in RCW 15.80.480.

25 **Sec. 3.** RCW 15.80.490 and 1969 ex.s. c 100 s 20 are each amended
26 to read as follows:

27 Any weighmaster may file an application with the director for a
28 license for any employee or agent to operate and issue certified weight
29 tickets from a scale which such weighmaster is licensed to operate
30 under the provisions of this chapter. Such application shall be
31 submitted on a form prescribed by the director and shall contain the
32 following:

33 (1) Name of the weighmaster;

34 (2) The full name of the employee or agent and his resident
35 address;

36 (3) The position held by such person with the weighmaster;

1 (4) The scale or scales from which such employee or agent will
2 issue certified weights; and

3 (5) Signature of the weigher and the weighmaster.

4 Such annual application shall be accompanied by a license fee of
5 ((five)) ten dollars.

6 **Sec. 4.** RCW 19.94.2582 and 1995 c 355 s 16 are each amended to
7 read as follows:

8 (1) Each request for an official registration certificate shall be
9 in writing, under oath, and on a form prescribed by the department and
10 shall contain any relevant information as the director may require,
11 including but not limited to the following:

12 (a) The name and address of the person, corporation, partnership,
13 or sole proprietorship requesting registration;

14 (b) The names and addresses of all individuals requesting an
15 official registration certificate from the department; and

16 (c) The tax registration number as required under RCW 82.32.030 or
17 uniform business identifier provided on a master license issued under
18 RCW 19.02.070.

19 (2) Each individual when submitting a request for an official
20 registration certificate or a renewal of such a certificate shall pay
21 a fee to the department in the amount of ((eighty)) one hundred sixty
22 dollars per individual.

23 (3) The department shall issue a decision on a request for an
24 official registration certificate within twenty days of receipt of the
25 request. If an individual is denied their request for an official
26 registration certificate, the department must notify that individual in
27 writing stating the reasons for the denial and shall refund any
28 payments made by that individual in connection with the request.

29 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** The department of agriculture shall provide
30 a report to appropriate committees of the legislature on the status of
31 the weights and measures program by December 15, 2007.

32 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 6.** This act takes effect July 1, 2006.

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
