1 AN ACT Relating to reciprocity of concealed pistol licenses; and
2 amending RCW 9.41.073.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9.41.073 and 2004 c 148 s 1 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1)(a) A person licensed to carry a pistol in a state the laws of
7 which recognize and give effect in that state to a concealed pistol
8 license issued under the laws of the state of Washington is authorized
9 to carry a concealed pistol in this state if:

10 (i) ~~The ((licensing state does not issue concealed pistol licenses~~
11 ~~to persons under)) person to whom the license is issued is at least~~
12 twenty-one years of age; and

13 (ii) The licensing state requires mandatory fingerprint-based
14 background checks of criminal and mental health history, where
15 available by law, for all persons who apply for a concealed pistol
16 license.

17 (b) This section applies to a license holder from another state
18 only while the license holder is not a resident of this state. A

1 license holder from another state must carry the handgun in compliance
2 with the laws of this state.

3 (2) The attorney general shall periodically publish a list of
4 states the laws of which recognize and give effect in that state to a
5 concealed pistol license issued under the laws of the state of
6 Washington and which meet the requirements of subsection (1)(a)(i) and
7 (ii) of this section.
