- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 77.32 RCW to read as follows:
 - (1) Hunting is prohibited within one mile of a public or private school serving students in preschool through the 12th grade. The prohibition on hunting is in effect during school hours and during any scheduled school activity or event. The department may authorize a special hunting season if it determines that there is a need to hunt animals that pose a threat to human safety.
- 12 (2) This section applies only to counties with population densities 13 of greater than one hundred persons per square mile, as determined by 14 the office of financial management, or any county if adopted by the 15 legislative authority of that county.
