1 AN ACT Relating to use of vehicle headlights; and amending RCW
2 46.37.020.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.37.020 and 1977 ex.s. c 355 s 2 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 Every vehicle upon a highway within this state at any time from a
7 half hour after sunset to a half hour before sunrise (~~and~~), at any
8 other time when, due to insufficient light or unfavorable atmospheric
9 conditions, persons and vehicles on the highway are not clearly
10 discernible at a distance of one thousand feet ahead, and at all times
11 from two o'clock a.m. Pacific Standard Time on the last Sunday in
12 October until two o'clock a.m. Pacific Standard Time on the first
13 Sunday in April, shall display lighted headlights, other lights, and
14 illuminating devices as hereinafter respectively required for different
15 classes of vehicles, subject to exceptions with respect to parked
16 vehicles, and such stop lights, turn signals, and other signaling
17 devices shall be lighted as prescribed for the use of such devices.
