1 AN ACT Relating to allowing spas and art galleries to serve wine to  
2 their customers who are twenty-one years of age or older; and adding  
3 new sections to chapter 66.12 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 66.12 RCW  
6 to read as follows:

7 (1) Nothing in this title applies to or prevents a spa or art  
8 gallery from offering or supplying without charge wine by the  
9 individual glass to a customer for consumption on the premises.  
10 However, the customer must be at least twenty-one years of age and may  
11 only be offered one glass of wine, and the wine must have been legally  
12 purchased under this title. If the wine is offered by a spa that  
13 provides massages, the wine may not be offered to the customer until  
14 the massage is completed.

15 (2) For the purposes of this section, "spa" means a business that  
16 offers beauty services including, but not limited to, shampooing,  
17 cutting, styling, or dyeing hair, manicures, pedicures, facials,  
18 massages, and the use of body toning equipment.

1           (3) For purposes of this section, "art gallery" means a room or  
2 building devoted to the exhibition and/or sale of the works of art.

3           NEW SECTION.   **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 66.12 RCW  
4 to read as follows:

5           The board may adopt rules to implement section 1 of this act.
