1 AN ACT Relating to encouraging the use of hydroelectric power as a

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that:
- 6 (1) Water is a clean and sustainable resource that produces clean, 7 efficient, and low-cost power;
 - (2) There is an increasing demand for clean and renewable power;
- 9 (3) Hydroelectric power is an abundant and reliable source of power 10 with potential for growth;
- 11 (4) Hydroelectric power makes a valuable contribution to the
- 12 state's electricity network and accounts for more than half of the
- 13 state's overall fuel mix; and
- 14 (5) Hydroelectric power balances the needs of the environment with
- 15 the need for clean, nonpolluting, reliable, and abundant electricity
- 16 for the electrical market.
- 17 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 43.21F RCW
- 18 to read as follows:
