## SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 6775

State of Washington 59th Legislature 2006 Regular Session

**By** Senate Committee on Human Services & Corrections (originally sponsored by Senators Hargrove, Stevens, Rasmussen and McAuliffe; by request of Attorney General)

READ FIRST TIME 02/03/06.

AN ACT Relating to criminal trespass against children by sex offenders; reenacting and amending RCW 9.94A.515; adding new sections to chapter 9A.44 RCW; creating a new section; prescribing penalties; and declaring an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. It is the intent of the legislature to give 7 public and private entities that provide services to children the tools 8 necessary to prevent convicted child sex offenders from contacting 9 children when those children are within the legal boundaries of the 10 covered public and private entities.

11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 9A.44 RCW 12 to read as follows:

13

As used in this section and sections 3 and 4 of this act:

(1) "Covered entity" means any public facility or private facility
whose primary purpose, at any time, is to provide for the education,
care, or recreation of a child or children, including but not limited
to community and recreational centers, playgrounds, schools, swimming
pools, and state or municipal parks.

(2) "Child" means a person under the age of eighteen, unless the 1 2 context clearly indicates that the term is otherwise defined in 3 statute.

(3) "Public facility" means a facility operated by a unit of local 4 5 or state government, or by a nonprofit organization.

(4) "Schools" means public and private schools, but does not б 7 include home-based instruction as defined in RCW 28A.225.010.

(5) "Covered offender" means a person who is eighteen years of age older, who is not under the jurisdiction of the juvenile 9 or rehabilitation authority or currently serving a special sex offender 10 disposition alternative, whose risk level classification has been 11 12 assessed at a risk level II or a risk level III pursuant to RCW 13 72.09.345, and who, at any time, has been convicted of one or more of 14 the following offenses:

(a) Rape of a child in the first, second, and third degree; child 15 molestation in the first, second, and third degree; indecent liberties 16 17 against a child under age fourteen; sexual misconduct with a minor in the first and second degree; incest in the first and second degree; 18 luring with sexual motivation; possession of depictions of minors 19 engaged in sexually explicit conduct; dealing in depictions of minors 20 21 engaged in sexually explicit conduct; bringing into the state 22 depictions of minors engaged in sexually explicit conduct; sexual exploitation of a minor; communicating with a minor for immoral 23 24 purposes; patronizing a juvenile prostitute;

25 (b) Indecent liberties against a child under age fifteen; statutory rape in the first and second degree; carnal knowledge; 26

27 (c) Any felony offense for which:

(i) There was a finding that the offense was committed with sexual 28 29 motivation; and

(ii) The victim of the offense was less than sixteen years of age 30 31 at the time of the offense;

32 (d) An attempt, conspiracy, or solicitation to commit any of the offenses listed in (a) through (c) of this subsection; 33

(e) Any conviction from any other jurisdiction which is comparable 34 to any of the offenses listed in (a) through (d) of this subsection. 35

36 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 9A.44 RCW 37 to read as follows:

p. 2

1 (1) An owner, employee, or agent of a covered entity may order a 2 covered offender from the legal premises of a covered entity as 3 provided under this section. To do this, the owner, employee, or agent 4 of a covered entity must first personally serve on the covered offender 5 a written notice that informs the covered offender that:

6 (a) The covered offender must leave the legal premises of the 7 covered entity and may not return without the written permission of the 8 covered entity; and

9 (b) If the covered offender refuses to leave the legal boundaries 10 of the covered entity, or thereafter returns and enters within the 11 legal boundaries of the covered entity, the offender may be charged and 12 prosecuted for a felony offense as provided in section 4 of this act.

13 (2) An owner, employee, or agent of a covered entity shall be 14 immune from civil liability for damages arising from ejecting covered 15 offenders from a covered entity.

16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 9A.44 RCW 17 to read as follows:

(1) A person is guilty of the crime of criminal trespass againstchildren if he or she:

20 (a) Is a covered offender as defined in section 2 of this act;

(b) Receives written notice that complies with the requirements of section 3 of this act that he or she is not permitted to remain upon or reenter the legal boundaries of the covered entity; and

(c) Remains upon or reenters the legal boundaries of the coveredentity without the written permission of the covered entity.

26 (2) Criminal trespass against children is a class C felony.

27 Sec. 5. RCW 9.94A.515 and 2005 c 458 s 2 and 2005 c 183 s 9 are 28 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 6. If any provision of this act or its 19 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the 20 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other 21 persons or circumstances is not affected.

22 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 7. This act is necessary for the immediate 23 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the 24 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect 25 immediately.
