- AN ACT Relating to fluorescent yellow license plates for persons convicted of driving under the influence; reenacting and amending RCW 46.63.020; adding a new section to chapter 46.16 RCW; adding a new
- 4 section to chapter 46.61 RCW; and prescribing penalties.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW to read as follows:
- 8 The department shall create and issue a vehicle license number 9 plate, for display at the front and rear of a motor vehicle, available
- only to those convicted of a crime pursuant to RCW 46.61.502. Both
- 11 front and rear license plates shall be fluorescent yellow but otherwise
- 12 conform to the standards described within this chapter.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW to read as follows:
- Any person convicted of a crime pursuant to RCW 46.61.502 who has
- 16 no prior offense may not operate a motor vehicle, which does not have
- 17 fluorescent yellow license plates issued under section 1 of this act,
- 18 for a term of one year from the date of conviction or final resolution

- on appeal. A person convicted of a crime pursuant to RCW 46.61.502 who
- 2 has a prior conviction under RCW 46.61.502 shall not operate a motor
- 3 vehicle unless it has fluorescent yellow license plates issued under

- 5 **Sec. 3.** RCW 46.63.020 and 2005 c 431 s 2, 2005 c 323 s 3, and 2005 c 183 s 10 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

Failure to perform any act required or the performance of any act prohibited by this title or an equivalent administrative regulation or local law, ordinance, regulation, or resolution relating to traffic including parking, standing, stopping, and pedestrian offenses, is designated as a traffic infraction and may not be classified as a criminal offense, except for an offense contained in the following provisions of this title or a violation of an equivalent administrative regulation or local law, ordinance, regulation, or resolution:
