We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully represent and petition as follows:

WHEREAS, Mr. William P. Stewart (12/9/1839 - 12/11/1907) of Snohomish served bravely during the Civil War, volunteering to fight in the 29th Colored Infantry; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. William P. Stewart and his fellow soldiers faced 11 horrible odds, with one in three becoming casualties during the war; 12 and

WHEREAS, Mr. William P. Stewart, while fighting with General William Smith's 18th Corps, saw almost daily combat at the front; and

WHEREAS, Mr. William P. Stewart and his fellow soldiers from black regiments fought hard and suffered the greatest rates of wounds and death, yet saw little recognition after the war; and

WHEREAS, Mr. William P. Stewart was a farmer before he volunteered for combat, and married Elizabeth Thorton and became a highly respected
