WHEREAS, Tax fairness between Washington and Oregon is a major issue which impacts the lives of over 60,000 Washington residents who work in Oregon and pay Oregon income tax; and

WHEREAS, These same Washington residents also pay Washington state sales tax, in effect, paying taxes twice, while Oregon residents are exempt from Washington sales tax; and
