- AN ACT Relating to assumption by a code city with a population greater than one hundred thousand of a water-sewer district with fewer than two hundred fifty customers; and adding a new section to chapter
- 4 35.13A RCW.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 35.13A RCW 7 to read as follows:
- 8 The board of commissioners of a water-sewer district, with fewer
- 9 than two hundred fifty customers on the effective date of this act, and
- 10 the city council of a code city with a population greater than one
- 11 hundred thousand on the effective date of this act, may provide for
- 12 assumption by the city of the district in accordance with RCW
- 13 35.13A.020, except as provided herein, pursuant to the terms and
- 14 conditions of a contract executed in accordance with RCW 35.13A.070.
- 15 None of the territory of the water-sewer district need be included
- 16 within the territory of the city. The contract and assumption shall be
- 17 approved by resolution of the board of commissioners and ordinance of
- 18 the city council. If the water-sewer district has no indebtedness or
- 19 monetary obligations on the date of assumption, the city shall use any

- 1 surplus funds only for water services delivered to and water facilities
- 2 constructed in the former territory of the district, unless provided
- 3 otherwise in the contract. In connection with the assumption, the
- 4 water-sewer district or the city, or both, may provide for dissolution
- of the district pursuant to RCW 35.13A.080.
