1            AN ACT Relating to the public employees' benefits board offering a  
2            tricare supplemental insurance policy to employees who are eligible for  
3            this policy, but not eligible for medicare parts A and B; and adding a  
4            new section to chapter 41.05 RCW.

5            BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 41.05 RCW  
7            to read as follows:

8            (1) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter or rules  
9            or procedures adopted by the authority under this chapter, the  
10           authority may make available a tricare supplemental insurance policy,  
11           32 C.F.R. Sec. 199.17 (2004), to employees who are eligible. This  
12           supplemental policy may be offered as one of the board's health  
13           coverage options. Employee selection of this supplemental policy is  
14           exclusive of selecting any other medical coverage offered through the  
15           board. If offered by the board, this supplemental policy shall be made  
16           available to employees, and retired or disabled employees, eligible for  
17           coverage available under the authority, but not eligible for medicare  
18           parts A and B.

1           (2) The administrator may adopt rules to carry out the purposes of  
2 this section.

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
