1 AN ACT Relating to University of Washington dental school faculty; 2 and amending RCW 18.32.195.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 18.32.195 and 1994 sp.s. c 9 s 218 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 The commission may, without examination, issue a license to persons 7 who possess the qualifications set forth in this section.

8 (1) The commission may, upon written request of the dean of the school of dentistry of the University of Washington, issue a license to 9 10 practice dentistry in this state to persons who have been licensed or 11 otherwise authorized to practice dentistry in another state or country 12 and who have been accepted for employment by the school of dentistry as ((full-time)) faculty members. For purposes of this subsection, this 13 means teaching members of the faculty of the school of dentistry of the 14 15 University of Washington ((who are so employed on a one hundred percent 16 of work time basis)). Such license shall permit the holder thereof to practice dentistry within the confines of the university facilities for 17 a period of one year while he or she is so employed as a ((full time)) 18 19 faculty member by the school of dentistry of the University of

Washington. It shall terminate whenever the holder ceases to be ((such)) a ((full-time)) faculty member. Such license shall permit the holder thereof to practice dentistry only in connection with his or her duties in employment with the school of dentistry of the University of Washington. This limitation shall be stated on the license.

6 (2) The commission may, upon written request of the dean of the 7 school of dentistry of the University of Washington, issue a limited 8 license to practice dentistry in this state to university residents in 9 postgraduate dental education. The license shall permit the resident 10 dentist to provide dental care only in connection with his or her 11 duties as a university resident.

12 (3) The commission may condition the granting of a license under this section with terms the commission deems appropriate. All persons 13 licensed under this section shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the 14 commission to the same extent as other members of the dental 15 profession, in accordance with this chapter, and in addition the 16 17 licensee may be disciplined by the commission after a hearing has been held in accordance with the provisions set forth in this chapter, and 18 determination by the commission that such licensee has violated any of 19 the restrictions set forth in this section. 20

21 (4) Persons applying for licensure pursuant to this section shall 22 pay the application fee determined by the secretary and, in the event the license applied for is issued, a license fee at the rate provided 23 24 for licenses generally. After review by the commission, licenses 25 issued under this section may be renewed annually if the licensee continues to be employed as a ((full-time)) faculty member of the 26 27 school of dentistry of the University of Washington, or a university resident in postgraduate dental education, and otherwise meets the 28 requirements of the provisions and conditions deemed appropriate by the 29 commission. Any person who obtains a license pursuant to this section 30 31 may, without an additional application fee, apply for licensure under 32 this chapter, in which case the applicant shall be subject to examination and the other requirements of this chapter. 33
