1 fund. Regulatory fees payable by all types of public service companies
2 shall be deposited to the credit of the public service revolving fund.
3 Except for expenses payable out of the pipeline safety account, all
4 expense of operation of the Washington utilities and transportation
5 commission shall be payable out of the public service revolving fund.

6 During the 2003-2005 fiscal biennium, the legislature may transfer
7 from the public service revolving fund to the state general fund such
8 amounts as reflect the excess fund balance of the fund.

9 Due to the extraordinarily high winter energy costs, during the
10 2005-2007 fiscal biennium, no more than seven million six hundred
11 thousand dollars, as appropriated in section 1 of this act, shall be
12 payable out of the public service revolving fund to provide energy
13 assistance to customers in accordance with the low-income energy
14 assistance program.

15 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate
16 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
17 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
18 immediately.
