AN ACT Relating to assisted living facility medicaid minimum cocupancy percentage of fifty percent or greater; adding a new section to chapter 74.39A RCW; and providing an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 74.39A RCW 6 to read as follows:

7 (1) To the extent funds are appropriated for this purpose, the 8 department shall establish a capital add-on rate, not less than the 9 July 1, 2005, capital add-on rate established by the department, for 10 those assisted living facilities contracting with the department that 11 have a medicaid occupancy percentage of sixty percent or greater.

12 (2) Effective for July 1, 2006, and for each July 1st rate-setting 13 period thereafter, the department shall determine the facility's 14 medicaid occupancy percentage using the last six months' medicaid 15 resident days from the preceding calendar year divided by the product 16 of all its licensed boarding home beds irrespective of use, times 17 calendar days for the six-month period. For the purposes of this 18 section, medicaid resident days include those clients who are enrolled in a medicaid managed long-term care program, including but not limited to the program for all inclusive care and the medicaid integration project.

4 (3) The medicaid occupancy percentage established beginning on July 5 1, 2006, and for each July 1st thereafter, shall be used to determine 6 whether an assisted living facility qualifies for the capital add-on 7 rate under this section. Those facilities that qualify for the capital 8 add-on rate shall receive the capital add-on rate throughout the 9 applicable fiscal year.
