1 AN ACT Relating to recreational fishing for albacore tuna; and 2 amending RCW 77.32.010.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.32.010 and 2001 c 253 s 49 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, a recreational 7 license issued by the director is required to hunt for or take wild 8 animals or wild birds, fish for, take, or harvest fish, shellfish, and 9 seaweed. A recreational fishing or shellfish license is not required 10 for carp, smelt, ((albacore,)) and crawfish, and a hunting license is 11 not required for bullfrogs.

12 (2) A permit issued by the department is required to park a motor13 vehicle upon improved department access facilities.
