SB 6881 By Senators Kline and Rasmussen Extending the limitation period for personal injury actions involving acts that would constitute sex offenses. Referred to Committee on JUDICIARY.

- SB 6884 By Senators Fairley and Rasmussen Providing for the care and education of children in licensed staffed residential homes. Referred to Committee on HEALTH & LONG-TERM CARE.
