

SHB 2796 - H AMD 1093

1 On page 1, beginning on line 17, after "(2)" strike all
2 material through "number" on page 2, line 5 and insert "No ballot
3 may be issued with a unique identifying mark, except as
4 specifically authorized by this subsection. A ballot may be issued
5 with a randomly assigned unique identifying mark solely for
6 auditing and vote reconciliation purposes, or to determine if a
7 particular ballot has been previously counted, as long as it is not
8 associated with an individual voter, a voter's address, or a
9 voter's registration number"

EFFECT: Clarifies when unique identifying marks may be used on a ballot by election officials.
