1 On page 6, after line 16 of the amendment, insert the
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 6.** (1) The work product delivered by the
4 marine managed areas work group established in section 5 of this
5 act must include at least one case study regarding how consistent
6 standards, methods, or protocols that may aid governmental
7 organizations with the future identification of marine managed
8 areas can be developed.

9 (2) The case study required by this section must be designed to
10 analyze how and when future marine managed areas can or should be
11 developed in urbanized areas where the purpose of the marine
12 protected area is to protect the marine shoreline and adjacent
13 upland environmental, cultural, or community values.

14 (3) The case study required by this section must be located in
15 an urban marine waterway located in Puget Sound adjacent to uplands
16 areas available for public access that includes at least one park
17 area developed, in part, with money from the Washington wildlife
18 and recreation program that includes or is planning to include a
19 seawall, walking paths, interpretive displays, and a cultural
20 botanical display area and includes within the borders of the case
21 study area at least one nearby area of state-owned aquatic lands
22 currently under lease with the department of natural resources for
23 use as an industrial marine repair facility capable of servicing
24 marine vessels that are seventy-five feet or more in length.

25 (4) Until the results of the case study required by this
26 section are delivered to the leadership council of the Puget Sound
27 partnership as part of the work product required by section 5 of
28 this act, the city government with jurisdiction over uplands
29 adjacent to the case study area is prohibited from allowing any
30 shoreline uses or expansions not currently authorized for

1 shorelines located within or adjacent to the case study area if the
2 shoreline use or expansion is related to an industrial use capable
3 of performing any of the following actions on marine vessels that
4 are seventy-five feet or more in length: Construction,
5 refurbishment, maintenance, repair, lay berthing, or demolition."

6 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively, correct internal
7 references accordingly, and correct the title.

EFFECT: Requires the work group responsible for aiding in the development of the marine managed areas plan to conduct a case study in an urban waterway with specific qualities to determine a process for the future identification of marine managed areas and prohibits certain industrial uses in the case study area until the case study is complete.
