EFFECT: Removes the requirement that waivers for veterans' families are subject to the statutory waiver limits of institutions of higher education, and reinstates current law which provides that waivers for veterans' families are not subject to the statutory waiver limits. Requires reports to the Legislature regarding the status of implementation of these waivers.
