1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
2 following:

3 "Sec. 1. RCW 70.95M.115 and 2006 c 231 s 2 are each amended to
4 read as follows:

5 (1) Beginning July 1, 2007, a person who is known to be pregnant or
6 who is under three years of age shall not be vaccinated with a
7 mercury-containing vaccine or injected with a mercury-containing
8 product that contains more than 0.5 micrograms of mercury per 0.5
9 milliliter dose.

10 (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, an influenza
11 vaccine may contain up to 1.0 micrograms of mercury per 0.5 milliliter
12 dose.

13 (3) The secretary of the department of health may, upon the
14 secretary's or local public health officer's declaration of (~~a public~~
15 ~~health emergency~~) an outbreak of vaccine-preventable disease or of a
16 shortage of vaccine that complies with subsection (1) or (2) of this
17 section, suspend the requirements of this section for the duration of
18 the (~~emergency~~) outbreak or shortage.

19 (4) A person who is known to be pregnant or a parent or legal
20 guardian of a child under eighteen years of age shall be informed if
21 the person or child is to be vaccinated or injected with any mercury-
22 containing product that contains more than the mercury limits per dose
23 in subsections (1) and (2) of this section.

24 (5) All vaccines and products referenced under this section must
25 meet food and drug administration licensing requirements."
