

ESHB 2878 - S AMD TO S COMM AMD (S-5725.2/08) **172**
By Senators Stevens and Hobbs

NOT ADOPTED 2/27/2008

1 On page 71, after line 20 of the amendment, insert the following:

2 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 603.** A new section is added to chapter 46.68 to
3 read as follows:

4 The one Washington road account is created in the motor vehicle
5 fund. Money in the account shall be spent only after appropriation.
6 Expenditures from the account shall be used only for highway purposes
7 identified in the omnibus transportation budget and to pay the
8 principal and interest on the bonds authorized for Washington road
9 account projects or improvements. Because state route number 2 between
10 Everett and Stevens pass continues to experience a disproportionate
11 number of fatality and serious injury accidents and has been designated
12 as a safety corridor by the governor, this corridor must receive
13 priority consideration for any expenditures from this account. For the
14 purposes of this section "highway purposes" has the same meaning as in
15 Article II, section 40 of the Washington State Constitution.

16 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 604.** A new section is added to chapter 82.32 to
17 read as follows:

18 (1) The department shall deposit into the one Washington road
19 account all revenue received from taxes imposed under chapters 82.08
20 and 82.12 RCW, as provided in subsection (2) of this section, upon
21 the sale of, use of, or charge made for:

22 (a) Motor vehicles, trailers, and semitrailers used, or of the
23 type designed primarily to be used, upon the public streets and
24 highways, for the convenience or pleasure of the owner, or for the
25 conveyance, for hire, or otherwise of persons or property, including
26 fixed loads and facilities for human habitation; but not including:
27 (i) Dock and warehouse tractors and their cars or trailers, lumber
28 carriers of the type known as spiders, and all other automotive
29 equipment not designed primarily for use upon public streets or
30 highways, (ii) motor vehicles or their trailers used entirely upon
31 private property, or (iii) mobile homes, as defined in RCW 46.04.302;

1 (b) Travel trailers, as defined in RCW 46.04.623;
2 (c) Campers, as defined in RCW 46.04.085;
3 (d) Materials, labor, equipment, contracts, and components used
4 for building, repairing, or improving of any publicly owned street,
5 place, road, highway, easement, right-of-way, mass public
6 transportation terminal or parking facility, bridge, tunnel, or
7 trestle as described in RCW 82.04.050; and
8 (e) Construction, improvement, or repair of a ferry, ferry
9 terminal, or other facility operated by the Washington state ferries
10 or for the repair, overhaul, or the dry docking of any ferry operated
11 by the Washington state ferries.
12 (2) The department must deposit revenue received under
13 subsection (1) of this section into the one Washington road account,
14 created under section 1 of this act, as follows:
15 (a) Twenty percent of all revenue received during fiscal year 2008;
16 (b) Forty percent of all revenue received during fiscal year 2009;
17 (c) Sixty percent of all revenue received during fiscal year 2010;
18 (d) Eighty percent of all revenue received during fiscal year
19 2011; and
20 (e) One hundred percent of all revenue received during fiscal
21 year 2012 and thereafter."

23 Renumber the sections consecutively and correct any internal
24 references accordingly.

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EFFECT: Creates the One Washington road account. Designates to the account sales taxes received from the sale of various motor vehicles and sales taxes related to road construction projects and ferry construction projects. Identified revenues shall be gradually directed toward the account beginning with 20% in fiscal year 2008 until 100% of the revenues received in 2012 and thereafter are directed into the account. Projects on US 2 are directed to receive priority consideration in expenditure from the account because of serious injury accidents and the corridors designation as a safety corridor.
