Title: An act relating to including supreme court and court of appeals commissioners to solemnize marriages.

Brief Description: Including supreme court and court of appeals commissioners to solemnize marriages.

Sponsors: Senators Marr, Kline and McCaslin; by request of Court Of Appeals.

Brief Summary of Bill

- Allows Supreme Court commissioners and Court of Appeals commissioners to solemnize marriages.

Background:

The following persons, active or retired, are authorized to solemnize marriages:

- Supreme Court justices;
- Court of Appeals, superior court, and district and municipal court judges;
- Superior Court commissioners; and
- any regularly licensed or ordained minister or any priest of any church or religious denomination.

Summary of Bill:

Supreme Court commissioners and Court of Appeals commissioners are authorized to solemnize marriages.

Appropriation: None.

Fiscal Note: Not requested.
