Title: An act relating to transportation funding and appropriations.

Brief Description: Making transportation appropriations for the 2005-07 and 2007-09 fiscal biennia.

Sponsors: House Committee on Transportation (originally sponsored by Representatives Clibborn, Jarrett and O'Brien; by request of Governor Gregoire).

Background: The operating and capital expenses of state transportation agencies and programs are funded on a biennial basis by an omnibus transportation budget adopted by the Legislature in odd-numbered years. Additionally, supplemental budgets may be adopted during the biennium making various modifications to agency appropriations.

Summary of Engrossed Substitute Bill: The bill as referred to committee not considered.

Summary of Proposed Amendment(s) As Heard In Committee (Transportation): Appropriations are made for state transportation agencies and programs for the 2007-09 fiscal biennium. Additionally, appropriations for various transportation agencies and programs are modified for the 2005-07 biennium. (See Committee supporting documents for more detail.)
