Title: An act relating to the worth of materials utilized for work performed under prudent utility management.

Background: Public utility districts (PUDs) must contract for work estimated to cost over \$10,000 or work using material costing over \$50,000.

Summary of Bill: The maximum cost of material used in work by PUDs without contracting is raised from \$50,000 to \$200,000.

Effective Date: Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.
