- AN ACT Relating to the Washington state quality award; and amending
- 2 RCW 43.17.390.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.17.390 and 2005 c 384 s 4 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) Starting no later than 2008, and at least once every three
- 7 years thereafter, each agency shall apply to the Washington state
- 8 quality award, or similar organization, for an independent assessment
- 9 of its quality management, accountability, and performance system.
- 10 Starting no later than 2010, and at least once every three years
- 11 thereafter, each agency shall apply to the annual Washington state
- 12 <u>quality award.</u> The assessment shall evaluate the effectiveness of all
- 13 elements of its management, accountability, and performance system,
- 14 including: Leadership, strategic planning, customer focus, analysis
- 15 and information, employee performance management, and process
- 16 improvement. The purpose of the assessment is to recognize best
- 17 practice and identify improvement opportunities.
- 18 (2) At the time of application for a Washington state quality award

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each agency shall provide the governor with a copy of the agency's application. The governor shall post all applications on a web page.

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5 6 (3) Agencies shall provide the governor with a copy of the scores or other feedback to the application upon receipt. The governor shall post all scores and feedback on a web page that agencies are ranked against each other.

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
