## SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 2244

- 1 AN ACT Relating to homeless tent encampments; and adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 43.185C RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.185C 5 RCW to read as follows:
- (1) Due to concerns about maintaining freedom of religious 6 7 expression, religious organizations shall not be restricted from 8 hosting temporary encampments for the homeless. A temporary encampment 9 may be subject to reasonable compliance requirements related to public health and safety. Fines may only be levied in cases in which the 10 religious organization has clearly endangered the public health or 11 12 safety of the community due to the presence of the temporary 13 encampment.
- 14 (2) Any applicable permit fees for temporary encampments may not exceed five hundred dollars.
- 16 (3) Counties, cities, and towns must respond to temporary 17 encampment permit applications submitted on behalf of religious 18 organizations within sixty days.
