1 AN ACT Relating to defining high demand; and creating a new
2 section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1) The legislature finds that many agencies
5 and institutions in Washington are directly and indirectly involved in
6 offering postsecondary education, preparing people for employment, and
7 assisting business and industry in accessing a skilled workforce. The
8 legislature also finds that significant amounts of funding are
9 appropriated to these agencies and institutions for the specific focus
10 of meeting needs in high-demand areas. Further, the legislature finds
11 that the agencies and institutions use a variety of different
12 definitions and criteria for determining what is high demand.

13 (2) The higher education coordinating board, the state board for
14 community and technical colleges, the office of financial management,
15 the employment security department, and the department of community,
16 trade, and economic development, shall work collaboratively to prepare
17 recommended legislation that includes a statutory definition of high
18 demand for use by the legislature and all agencies and institutions
19 that offer postsecondary education, employment preparation, and

1 workforce-related services to business and industry. The
2 recommendations and proposed legislation shall be submitted in a joint
3 report from all agencies listed in this section to the higher education
4 committees in the house of representatives and senate by November 1,
5 2007.
