
SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 2455

State of Washington 60th Legislature 2008 Regular Session

1 AN ACT Relating to the expiration of monetary value of fare media;
2 amending RCW 47.60.315; and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.60.315 and 2007 c 512 s 6 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) The commission shall adopt fares and pricing policies by rule,
7 under chapter 34.05 RCW, according to the following schedule:

8 (a) Each year the department shall provide the commission a report
9 of its review of fares and pricing policies, with recommendations for
10 the revision of fares and pricing policies for the ensuing year;

11 (b) By September 1st of each year, beginning in 2008, the
12 commission shall adopt by rule fares and pricing policies for the
13 ensuing year.

14 (2) The commission may adopt by rule fares that are effective for
15 more or less than one year for the purposes of transitioning to the
16 fare schedule in subsection (1) of this section.

17 (3) The commission may increase ferry fares included in the
18 schedule of charges adopted under this section by a percentage that
19 exceeds the fiscal growth factor.

1 (4) The chief executive officer of the ferry system may authorize
2 the use of promotional, discounted, and special event fares to the
3 general public and commercial enterprises for the purpose of maximizing
4 capacity use and the revenues collected by the ferry system. The
5 department shall report to the commission a summary of the promotional,
6 discounted, and special event fares offered during each fiscal year and
7 the financial results from these activities.

8 (5) Fare revenues and other revenues deposited in the Puget Sound
9 ferry operations account created in RCW 47.60.530 may not be used to
10 support the Puget Sound capital construction account created in RCW
11 47.60.505, unless the support for capital is separately identified in
12 the fare.

13 (6) The commission may not raise fares until the fare rules contain
14 pricing policies developed under RCW 47.60.290, or September 1, 2009,
15 whichever is later.

16 (7) The department may not enforce an expiration date of less than
17 one hundred twenty days on the monetary value of any fare media.

18 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. If specific funding for the purposes of this
19 act, referencing this act by bill or chapter number, is not provided by
20 June 30, 2008, in the omnibus transportation appropriations act, this
21 act is null and void.
